

Aiken City Council Minutes  
SPECIAL MEETING

August 18, 1994

Present: Mayor Cavanaugh, Councilmembers Anaclerio, Papouchado, Price and Radford.

Absent: Councilmembers Clyburn and Perry

Others Present: Steve Thompson, Frances Thomas, Andy Anderson, Sam Erb, Terry Rhinehart, Tom Nadolski, Bill Littrell, Phillip Lord of the Aiken Standard, Rolanda Hatcher of Augusta Chronicle and 4 citizens.

City Council met in a pre-Council session at 5:30 P.M. to discuss the request from Tom Nadolski, Chairman of the Aiken Olympic Training Coordination Committee, concerning funding from Accommodations Tax funds for the Olympic training activities at the shooting center near Windsor. The Committee would like to bring training teams from several countries to the South Carolina Outdoor Shooting Center located in Windsor.

The request from the Aiken Olympic Training Coordination Committee was for \$20,000 now and for \$10,000 next year.

Mayor Cavanaugh called the meeting to order at 5:55 P.M.


Mayor Cavanaugh reviewed the Aiken Olympic Training Coordination Committee presentation to Council on August 8 and asked Sam Erb, Chairman of the Accommodations Tax Committee, and Terry Rhinehart to make a report regarding the Accommodations Tax Committee recommendation.

Mr. Erb stated the Accommodations Tax Committee had received many good requests for funding but the resources were limited as the Committee only had \$52,000 to allocate. He stated the Accommodations Tax Committee had reviewed the request, along with other requests, and had recommended that the Aiken Olympic Training Coordination Committee be funded \$8,000 and that the request be reviewed later in the year for additional funds.

After discussion by Council, Councilman Anaclerio moved, seconded by Councilwoman Papouchado, and unanimously approved that Council adjust the recommendation by the Accommodations Tax Committee by \$2,000 and that a total of \$10,000 be funded to the Aiken Olympic Training Coordination Committee for the promotion of tourism and economic development and further that Council consider an additional \$10,000 with the addition of another team(s) later in the year.

ADJOURNMENT
