## For Immediate Release

Los Angeles (September 18, 2014) - South Carolina ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in the nation in overall highway performance and cost-effectiveness in the latest Annual Highway Report by Reason Foundation. South Carolina ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in the previous report.

South Carolina's highways rank 49<sup>th</sup> in fatality rate, 22<sup>nd</sup> in the percentage of deficient bridges, 13<sup>th</sup> in rural Interstate pavement condition, 15<sup>th</sup> in urban Interstate pavement condition and 29<sup>th</sup> in urban Interstate congestion.

On spending, South Carolina ranks 1<sup>st</sup> in total disbursements per mile and 6<sup>th</sup> in administrative disbursements per mile.

South Carolina's best rankings are total disbursements per mile (1<sup>st</sup>), capital and bridge disbursements per mile (3<sup>rd</sup>) and maintenance disbursements per mile (4<sup>th</sup>).

South Carolina's worst rankings are fatality rate (49<sup>th</sup>), urban Interstate congestion (29<sup>th</sup>) and narrow rural arterial lanes (29<sup>th</sup>).

South Carolina's state-controlled highway mileage makes it the 4<sup>th</sup> largest system in the country.
