

RECOMMENDATIONS OF EDUCATION COMMITTEE

August 17, 1976

The Education Committee recommends the following to the Board of Trustees:

1. That the Board of Trustees meet monthly as recommended in the NAPCAE Study Team Report. (September 15, 1975, p. 24)
2. That a member of the staff give a brief overview (approximately 10 minutes) of a specific area of the school program at each board meeting.  
Example: Principal - Instructional Program  
Dean of Students - Afternoon and Weekend Activities
3. That a cumulative folder be kept on each staff member.
4. That a staff evaluation form be developed and used for an annual evaluation. This form would be developed by the staff and presented to the Education Committee for their recommendation to the Board of Trustees.
