THOUSANDS OF BOY SCOUTS ACROSS THE STATE
HAVE A CHANCE THIS SPRING TO EARN THE NEW
"600 TABLES IN 60 DAYS" COMMEMORATIVE PATCH!

The South Carolina State Park Service, the Boy Scouts of America and Cox Industries of Orangeburg are teaming up to build 600 new picnic tables for the state's 47 state parks. Cox Industries is making the project possible because of its generous donation of time and materials. Scout groups can sign up starting in January to assemble tables between March 1 and April 30 at one of 32 participating state parks. Assembling a table is the only way to earn the 600 Tables in 60 Days commemorative patch.

Steps to participate in our 600 Tables in 60 Days challenge:

1. Choose the park where you would like to assemble tables. *(See list on back)*
2. Contact the park to schedule your trip and be ready with the information requested on the back of this sheet.
3. Collect your assembly instructions on your camping or service day.

Scout groups assembling tables will also receive free camping in the parks that have designated scout or primitive camping areas. Each table should take five boys approximately one hour to assemble with supervision. Scouts are eligible to receive up to five patches per table, not to exceed the number of participants.

The picnic table kits will be delivered to a lumber yard near your chosen park. *It is the responsibility of each individual troop to pick up their kits at the lumber yard prior to the camping trip or service day.* If you cannot pick up the kits, contact the park manager for assistance.
