Now comes the West Columbia Police Department, by and through its undersigned Chief, requesting that the City of West Columbia as it is governing body approve the multi-jurisdictional agreements pursuant to S.C. Code of Laws 23-20-50, which have been entered into pursuant to S.C. Code of Laws 23-1-215. The approval being sought through this document pursuant to S.C. Code of Laws 23-20-50 is stated in pertinent part as follows:

An agreement entered into pursuant to this chapter on behalf of a law enforcement authority must be approved by the appropriate state, county or local law enforcement authority's chief executive officer. A state law enforcement authority must provide a copy of the agreement to the Governor and the Executive Director of the State Budget and Control Board no later than one business day after executing the agreement. An agreement entered into with a local law enforcement authority pursuant to this chapter must be approved by the governing body of each jurisdiction. For agreements entered into prior to June 1 2000, the agreement may be ratified by the governing body of each jurisdiction.

The metro narcotics agreements that are the subject of the approval contained herein include:



METRO NARCOTICS AGREEMENT

It is agreed by and among the Chief of West Columbia Police Department and the Chief of Springdale Police Department that the officers listed below shall be transferred for a temporary period of time, to expire September 30, 2016, to work in illegal drug law enforcement in either West Columbia or Springdale pursuant to authority contained in 23-1-210 of the Code of Laws for South Carolina (1989, amended) and other applicable provisions of law.

It is further agreed by and among the Chief of West Columbia Police Department and the Chief of Springdale Police Department that each shall save the other harmless and each will indemnify the other for any acts or omissions of their officers working or transferred under the provisions of this agreement.

The temporary transfers provided by this agreement shall in no manner effect or reduce compensation, pension, or retirement rights of the transferred officers and such officers shall continue to be paid by the agency where they are permanently employed, with the sending agency being reimbursed for their services by the agency to which they are transferred.

Notwithstanding the other provisions of the instrument, the agency to which said officers are transferred shall not be responsible for financial reimbursements to the sending agency except to such extent, in such amount, and upon such conditions as have been agreed upon in writing between sending agency and the receiving agency prior to the sending of a transferred officer or officers to the receiving agency on a particular occasion of the need thereof. The parties will, as nearly as circumstances and need permit, make every effort to reimburse each other for such services by the providing of services of a like kind and quantity.

It is further understood that the entering agency will work under the supervision of the host agency.

It is also understood that the agency that enters the jurisdiction of another, the entering agency will be responsible for obtaining any warrants as a result of searches, seizures or arrests.

Also, it is understood by all parties to this agreement that any person listed on this document will contact the Narcotics Officers of the jurisdiction which they are entering and seek their assistance before any action is commenced in any manner (search warrants, arrests, surveillance).

It is also understood that any person arrested or any evidence seized will be held by the host agency.

It is understood that the entering agency will receive 100% of any seizure unless otherwise specified by the agencies involved.

It is also understood that any officer on this agreement may not enter another jurisdiction without the authorization of the host jurisdiction. (This in no way precludes the municipalities from entering into their own agreements).
