WHEREAS, children who are abused, neglected, or exploited are at a significant risk of entering the foster care system and suffering from a wide range of medical, emotional, psychological, and behavioral challenges; and


WHEREAS, every child deserves to grow up in a safe, loving, and stable family free from verbal, sexual, emotional, and physical abuse, exploitation, and neglect that violate a child's dignity, security, and stability; and

WHEREAS, the prevention of child abuse and neglect is a community issue that depends on the commitment of individuals, organizations, and government agencies to provide education, skills training, and support for parents in areas including child development, child safety, basic care skills, discipline strategies, and goal setting.
