Lieutenant Governor Bryant is from Anderson County, where he is a registered pharmacist and manages, with his brothers and father, Bryant Pharmacy & Supply. Bryant served in the South Carolina State Senate for 12 years until 2017. As a member of the Senate, he authored the 2013 provision creating the exceptional needs scholarship program benefiting students and parents across South Carolina, including many at Bob Jones Academy.

Bryant was elected President Pro Tempore of the South Carolina State Senate before being sworn in as South Carolina's 92nd Lieutenant Governor on January 25, 2017. As Lieutenant Governor, he remains committed to school choice for all South Carolina children and parents. He is married to his wife Ann and they have three children and a daughter-in-law.
