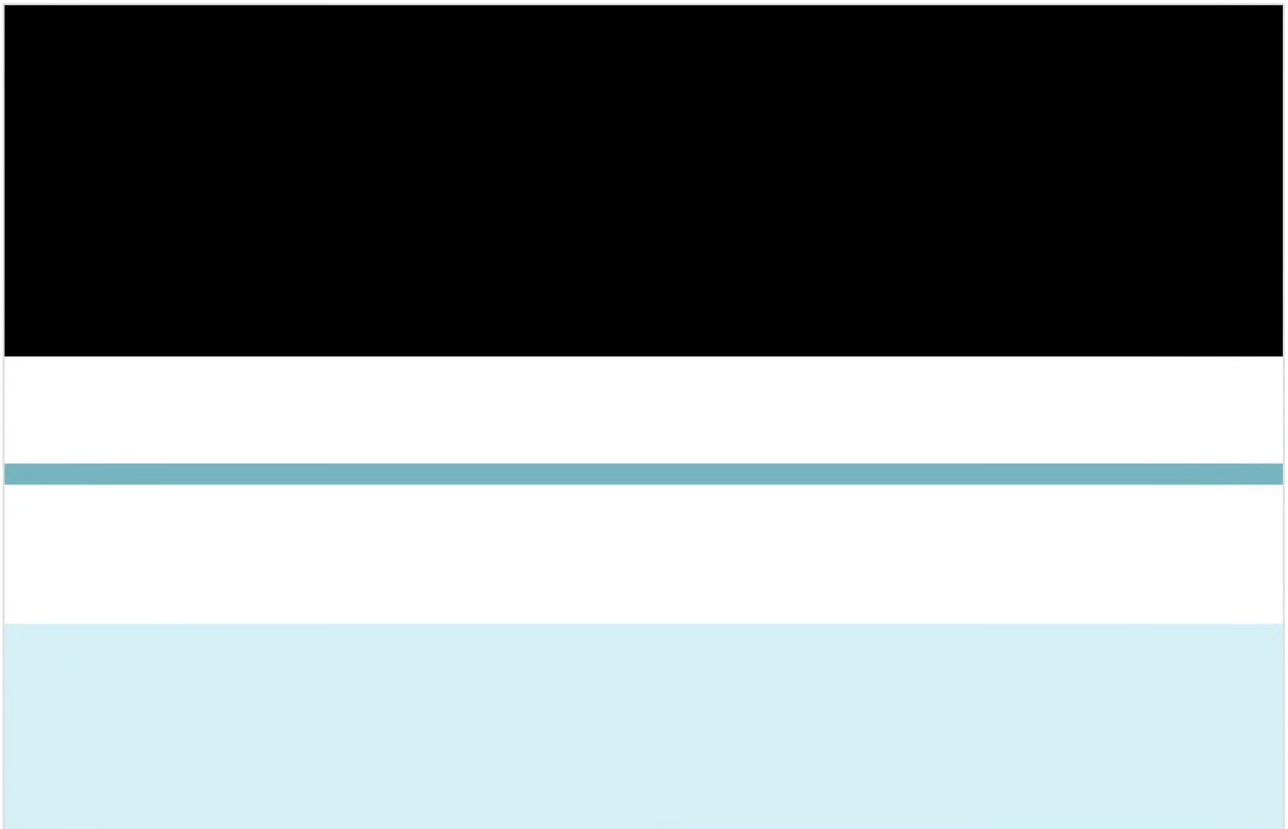

Nonprofit organizations, government agencies and universities are invited to apply for the seventh annual **Rosalinde Gilbert Innovations in Alzheimer's Disease Caregiving Legacy Award**. Through a grant to FCA's National Center on Caregiving from The Rosalinde and Arthur Gilbert Foundation, **three awards of \$20,000** each will be given to organizations in recognition of their unique programs addressing the needs of Alzheimer's caregivers. One award will be granted in each of three categories:

- ***Diverse/Multicultural Communities***
- ***Policy & Advocacy***
