Dear Governor:

I am writing to express my deepest disappointment in the political representatives' recent vote to refuse resettlement of refugees to South Carolina. Every citizen of South Carolina believes safety is of the utmost importance. However, your vote is not about safety. It is about fear of Muslims, and perhaps fear of an electorate that is entrenched in Islamophobia. As a Muslim who calls South Carolina my home, I want you to know that you are doing a very poor job of representing me and other Muslims here.
