Dear Ms. Morgan:

Thank you for your letter of June 13, 2109, which we received on June 21, regarding the above referenced proposed undertaking. We also received a Section 106 Project Review Form, maps, and photographs as supporting documentation. The State Historic Preservation Office is providing comments to the South Carolina Army National Guard (SCARNG) pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and its implementing regulations, 36 CFR 800. Consultation with the SHPO is not a substitution for consultation with Tribal Historic Preservation Offices, other Native American tribes, local governments, or the public.

The undertaking's Area of Potential Effect (APE) includes the Mount Pleasant Armory (SHPO Site Number 6305), a property eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Based on the submitted information, our office concurs that no properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places will be adversely affected by this undertaking. We believe that the Quonset Hut does not meet the criteria for listing in the National Register.

Our office recommends recording this resource as SHPO Site Number 6305.01 prior to demolition.
