We are excited to share that the turtle patrol at Edisto Beach State Park has found their first few nests of the season! In 45-60 days, the hatchlings will be ready to emerge and make their way to the ocean!

You can help our turtles by remembering to fill in any holes you dig, knock down sandcastles, pick up trash and make sure all of your belongings are off the beach once you are done for the day. As well, if you happen to be on the beach at night, be sure to only use red lights as white lights can disturb our nesting turtles. Thank you for helping us keep a dark, flat and clean beach!
