Homicide Support Group to hold 10th Annual National Day of Remembrance

(Charleston County, SC) On Sunday, September 25, 2016, at 4:00 p.m., members of the Survivors of Homicide Support Group and other homicide survivors (including DUI fatalities) will hold its Tenth Annual National Day of Remembrance for Murder Victims, with a brief ceremony at the Lonnie Hamilton Public Service Building, 4045 Bridge View Drive, North Charleston, SC, in Council Chambers. The Survivors of Homicide is a collaborative program between the Charleston County Sheriff's Office of Victim Assistance and the Medical University of SC Crime Victims Center, and presently meets four times per month in the tri-county area. This event is to commemorate the National Day of Remembrance for Murder Victims nationwide. It is also to honor the memories of murder victims and to recognize the impact on surviving family members and loved ones. Anyone losing a loved one to homicide, including traffic related homicides, is encouraged to attend, as well as victim assistance professionals working with homicide survivors. Survivors may bring a small picture of their loved ones if they so desire. Transportation maybe provided for survivors.
