Achieving energy independence would improve America's security, both economically and militarily. For this reason, South Carolina's researchers and businesses are working to further develop our existing resources while also finding innovative ways to expand access to offshore energy and various alternative fuels. Although fracking has received considerable attention in Pennsylvania and other Marcellus Formation states, the practice is unlikely to materialize in South Carolina, since we have no appreciable shale gas reserves.
