Adams Esq. his Majesty's Surveyor General for the Province aforesaid Dated the 13th day of April 1736 yeas I have advertised and laid out unto William Stephen Esq. the Elder of the Isle of Wight in the County of South Hampton the several of Barren & Land consisting of Twelve thousand Acres on the north East side of Savannah River as he being ordained constituted and appointed by John Hooley Esquire in Warrant of the said do belong unto the said and lawful attorney of the said Colonel Sarmont Hooley Esq. & in his name to ask and to do for the said Mr. Hooley Esq. and he himself in all respects for carrying on & seeing the said Land contained in the above warrant Completed as to the surveying & Laying out of the said conformable to said Bunting and Bounding to the South West on Savannah River to the South East on said Sarmont Hooley own part Barren & on vacant Land to the North East on vacant Land to the North West on said Sarmont Hooley Third Barren & with such shape Bunting as are Represented in the above delineated Plot I have under my Hand & Certified this Eighth day of July 1736 Per me J. O. Adams Esq. Surveyor
