students pay for college.

Still, I have no “political” experience.

All of my life never once did I dream of becoming President. I was busy making a difference. And that is exactly why I am running today.

I am not counting on lobbyists lining up to fund my campaign. I am counting on people like you and me. People that are sickened and ashamed of what has been coming out of Washington. People that are willing to stand up and fight for the future of our great country, because our children and their children are worth fighting for.
