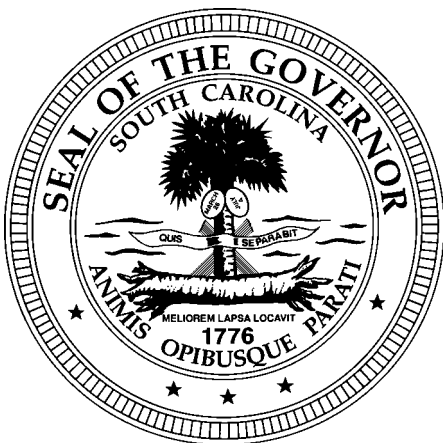
WHEREAS, the poultry industry directly employs over 7,700 of our state's citizens and contributes significantly to the earned income of our farm workers; and
