A regular meeting of the Anderson County Council was held on July 5, 1994 at 4:30 p.m. in the Anderson County Council Chambers - Old Courthouse - Second Floor.

Chairman Fred Tolly called the meeting to order and Mr. Tom Martin gave the invocation. Everyone stood and pledged allegiance to the flag.

On the motion of Mr. Banister, seconded by Mr. Floyd, Council voted unanimously to approve the June 7, 1994 minutes as mailed.

On the motion of Mr. Tolly, seconded by Mr. Floyd, Council voted unanimously to approve the June 21, 1994 minutes as mailed.

Mr. Tolly stated that Mr. Holden had an emergency to come up and would not attend the meeting.

Council heard from several concerned citizens at this time. Mr. Tom Hughes spoke in favor of the proposed sports complex.

Mr. Tolly presented third and final reading of Ordinance #94-015 - an ordinance to provide for the funding by user fees of the Chemical Emergency Response Team of Anderson County. A public hearing was held; no comments were heard. Mr. Floyd moved to approve Ordinance #94-015 on third reading and Mr. Allgood seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Tolly presented third and final reading of Ordinance #94-016 - Lease of real property to Al McClain. A public hearing was held and no comments were heard. Mr. Banister moved to approve and Mr. Tolly seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Tolly presented third and final reading of Ordinance #94-017 - Lease of real property to Al Dobbins. A public hearing was held; no comments were heard. Mr. Tolly moved to approve ordinance #94-017 on third reading and Mr. Floyd seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Tolly asked that third reading and public hearing on the multi-county business park (ordinance #94-019) be deferred until the later part of the meeting. Mr. Martin asked that the public hearing be held at this time while citizens are still present. A public hearing was held and no comments were heard. Vote on the ordinance will be held after an executive session.

Mr. Tolly presented second reading of Ordinance #94-018 - an ordinance to amend Anderson County Ordinance #7 - Anderson County Board of Assessment Appeals. A public hearing was held. Mr. Carl Johnson spoke. Mr. Allgood moved to approve on second reading and Mr. Banister seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Tolly presented Ordinance #94-020 - an ordinance of Anderson County relating to public nudity; prohibiting public nudity; defining terms; establishing exemptions to the prohibition against public nudity; providing an effect date. A public hearing was held the following persons spoke:

Mr. Tom Martin, County Attorney, made the following legal over-
view. He said that this ordinance deals with two constitutional
issues. 1-United States Supreme Court has indicated that nude
dancing is an art form protected by the First and Fourteenth
Amendments. Also, the Supreme Court has indicated that a commu-
nity can establish their own standards of obscenity. Therefore,
what the Council is doing by passing this ordinance is balancing
the two. It does not outlaw nudity; it outlaws obscenity. Mr.
Floyd moved to approve Ordinance #94-020 on second reading and
Mr. Banister seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Tolly presented second reading of Ordinance #94-021 - an
ordinance conveying property rights - Evergreen Properties. Mr.
Allgood moved to approve and Mr. Tolly seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Tolly asked that Ordinance #94-022 - an ordinance specifying
Anderson County Policy with regard to use of County materials,
equipment and personnel be deferred for consideration at the
next meeting. Council agreed.

Mr. Tolly presented Resolution #R94-019 - a resolution regarding
joint development of a recreation park/sports complex with the
City of Anderson, SC. Mr. Tolly explained that this would give
the consensus of Council, that the complex is doable and Council
would like to consider the situation further. Mr. Tolly moved
to approve and Mr. Floyd seconded. Council discussed. Mr.
Banister said that he was opposed from the beginning of the
annexation of the property into the City and is opposed to the
lease of the property for any reason. Mr. Floyd asked to go on
record stating that no land will be given away. Mr. Allgood
said he would support the complex; however, he would like a 50
year plan done by Planning. Vote was three in favor (Tolly,
Floyd and Allgood) and one opposed (Banister). Motion carried.

Mr. Tolly read a letter from the College of Commerce and Industry thanking Mr. Floyd for taking two consecutive days teaching young adults about County Government.

Mr. Floyd stated that he would introduce a newsletter to all Anderson County citizens at the next Council meeting showing the direction of the government and etc. Mr. Smoak is getting cost figures on this which should be ready by the next meeting.

Mr. Smoak presented a request for the relocation of Hampton Road by F & R Asphalt for \$167,703.65 in the vicinity of 81 and I-85. This is a fully funded coordinating Council grant and no county funds will be required. Mr. Allgood moved to accept the low bid from F & R Asphalt and Mr. Floyd seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Smoak presented a list of City Streets to be paved in the amount of \$35,126. He asked that this money be allocated through the 1993-1994 budget - District #2 paving. Mr. Floyd moved to do the paving and Mr. Tolly seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Smoak presented a change order for renovations at the Sheriff's office in the amount of \$900. This is for one of the holding cells and make it a polygraph room. Leveling the floor, installing carpeting, installing acoustical wall covering would be required. Mr. Tolly moved to approve this change order and Mr. Floyd seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Smoak explained that in August of 1992, Mountain Air Cargo had a contract and the County agreed to upgrade Hangar #4 at the County's expense. The amount would be \$21,209.24; the County was able to do it at that time and Mountain Air went ahead with renovations. They are now asking for reimbursement. The funds are available in the current Airport budget in account number 5211-000-375. Mr. Tolly moved to approve and Mr. Allgood seconded. Council discussed. Vote was 4-0.

The next item: "Boundary Line Expansion - Powdersville EMS" on the agenda was deferred for a recommendation from the EMS. Mr. Forest H. Thomas addressed the request. Council agreed to defer. Mr. Tolly said that in his opinion, it was up to the EMS Commission to make a recommendation to Council.

Mr. Smoak presented a request for a sewer line for Plastic Omnium. The engineering fee proposal for design of the line is \$1,200.00; no county funds will be involved. Mr. Tolly moved to approve and Mr. Allgood seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Tolly moved to go into executive session at 6:25 p.m. and Mr. Floyd seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Mr. Mr. Tolly moved to come out of executive session back into regular session at 7:05 p.m. Mr. Floyd seconded and vote was 3-0.


Mr. Banister had to leave during executive session.

During executive session, Council discussed one contractual matter concerning economic development.

Mr. Tolly presented Ordinance #94-019 - Multi-County Industrial Park with Clarendon County. Mr. Tolly explained that tracts 6, 20, 25, and 26 were added since second reading. These tracts will probably be renumbered. There is currently 27 tracts; 1-28 with one mission number in the middle. Mr. Tolly moved to approve ordinance #94-019 on third reading and give Mr. Smoak the authority to execute the agreement. Mr. Allgood seconded the motion. Mr. Allgood moved to amend the ordinance on third reading to include tracts 25, 26, 20 & 6 and Mr. Floyd seconded. Vote on the amendment was 3-0. Vote on the original motion as amended was 3-0.

There being no further business, Council adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
