Letter: Gov. Nikki Haley leads 16 governors in asking NLRB to dismiss case against Boeing

COLUMBIA, S.C. – Governor Nikki Haley, who will today testify at the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Oversight & Government Reform’s NLRB hearing, has organized a group of 16 governors to demand that the NLRB dismiss its case against The Boeing Company.

In a letter to NLRB Acting General Counsel Lafe Solomon, who will also testify at today’s hearing, the governors say, “When we, as governors, are fighting to improve the economic interests of our states, the federal government should not stand in our way. While governors are trying to break the ties that bind free enterprises from doing business, the federal government should not tell Boeing where it can build airplanes.”
