"We believe lowering taxes is crucial to the South Carolina's economic well-being and proved that there is ample room in the budget to pay for those tax cuts. In addition to \$140 million in permanent, recurring tax relief for our families and businesses, Governor Haley's executive budget places more than \$300 million into reserve. We are still reviewing the bills that the House finally introduced this week, and so far, we see a great deal of common ground. Once the Board of Economic Advisors weighs in with their independent assessment of the cost of the House package, we will be able to take a specific position on individual components of their plan."
