The United States is the No. 1 natural gas producer in the world, producing 78.9 billion cubic feet per day in 2017. Exports of liquefied natural gas (LNG) nearly **quadrupled** in 2017, making the U.S. a net natural gas exporter for the first time in nearly 60 years and supporting hundreds of thousands of jobs across the nation.

The numbers are impressive, but the economic and climate benefits they make possible are even more remarkable. In a new **series of short videos**, we've boiled down the natural gas advantage into five words:
