# Fuller Normal School in need of a facelift

On April 12, 1912, Bishop W.E. Fuller, Sr., being inspired by the Spirit of God, and feeling the need of a school for the education of the youth of his race, organized and founded the Fuller Normal and Industrial Institute at 240 Irwin Street, Atlanta, Georgia. On October 2, 1923, after careful deliberation, the school was moved to Greenville, South Carolina, where Reverend W.A. Barbour and his wife were operating a private school known as the Fuller Normal Junior School. The two schools were consolidated under the name of the Fuller Normal and Industrial Institute and located on St. Clair Street (now Hampton Avenue Extension, west of Washington Road).

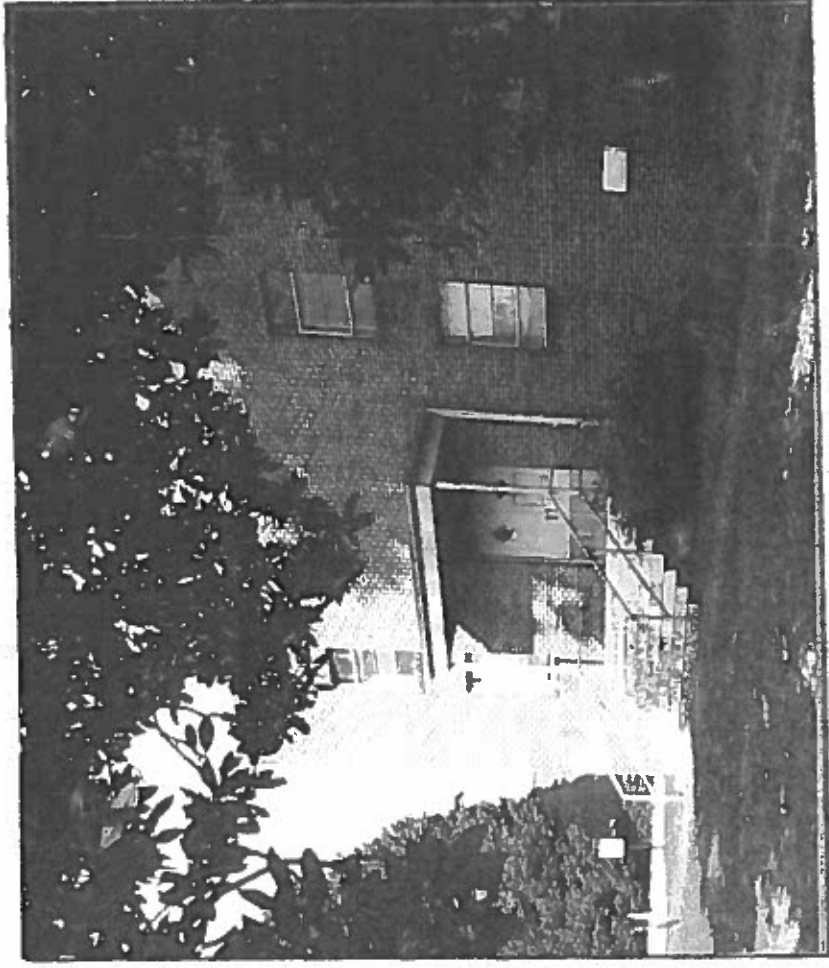
The school was moved to its present site in October, 1950, where a new building was erected to house boarding students, classrooms, administrative of-

fices, auditorium, and a dining room. The new school location covered a total of ten acres of land - 901 Anderson Road, Greenville, South Carolina.

The Fuller Normal and Industrial Institute has always been solely supported by the Fire Baptized Holiness Church of God of the Americas. Bishop W.E. Fuller, Sr., was the first president of FNII. The second president was Bishop W.E. Fuller, Jr. Fuller Normal School is now in the able hands of the third president, Bishop Patrick L. Frazier, Jr.
