Dear Mr. German,

On April 21, 2015, our office received your Freedom of Information Act request for the following:

“Any and all public records...reporting on or describing any specific programs or directives or orders or initiatives or pronouncements by the Governor of the State of South Carolina created to track the number of personal bankruptcies filed by citizens of South Carolina caused, or potentially caused by, the Governor’s [r]efusal to [e]xpand Medicaid.”

Our office will provide any and all records in our possession that are responsive to your request, subject to any exemptions or redactions as allowed pursuant to Section 30-4-40(a) of the South Carolina Code of Laws or as is otherwise exempt from disclosure by statute or regulation or prohibited from disclosure by court order.

Due to the high volume of Freedom of Information Act requests received by the Governor’s Office and the significant costs associated with producing the requests, our office will charge a reasonable cost for searching and copying records as allowed pursuant to Section 30-4-30(b).

Our office does not possess records responsive to your request.
