Hi Doug,

My name is Sarah Bowman and I am a reporter with The Island Packet, a paper down in Beaufort County. I am working on a story looking at how Gov. Haley's education initiative is affecting education funding in some districts.

For example, down in Beaufort County, the school district could lose about \$700,000 in EIA funding as it is re-routed or weighted based on free and reduced-price lunch, Medicaid, students not meeting state standards, etc.

I was just hoping to get a comment about this initiative and how it is effecting funding.
