EPA Awards South Carolina \$1.1 Million For Cleaner School Buses

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has awarded South Carolina more than \$1.1 million to replace 57 school buses with new cleaner models in 11 school districts.

The new and retrofitted buses will reduce pollutants that are linked to health problems such as asthma and lung damage. The funds are in the form of rebates through the EPA's Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA) funding.
