Description /Significant Features:

25-span T-beam bridge that carries southbound U.S. 301 over the South Edisto River. The 614-foot-long bridge was constructed in 1922. The original 1922 section was 18 feet wide and supported by reinforced concrete T-beam bents. It was widened twice, first in 1951 in-kind and again in 1973 through the addition of slab extensions supported by splayed prestressed concrete piles. Today it is 43 feet wide.
