The Commission approved an application by Dr. James C. Kinard, Chairman of the State Board of Public Welfare, to be permitted to increase the salary of Mr. Arthur B. Rivers, Director of the Department, to \$7,500.00 per year effective February 1, 1949.

The Commission declined to obligate itself to pay for repairing the main steam lines at the Medical College in Charleston in an amount of \$6,000.00, applied for by the Dean of the College.

The Commission approved employment by the Insurance Commissioner of Mr. L. George Benjamin, Jr., at a salary of \$150.00.

The Commission declined to approve the employment by the Insurance Commission of Mr. Wylie H. Grantham, as fire investigator, at a salary of \$300.00 per month.

The Commission then adjourned.
