WHEREAS, the Mitsubishi Polyester Film facility in Greer, South Carolina, is home to the administrative, manufacturing, marketing, and research and development headquarters for the production of HOSTAPHAN® film; and

WHEREAS, established in 1964, the facility covers more than one million square feet on its 193-acre site; and

WHEREAS, with approximately 500 full-time and 100 contract employees, the facility operates a 24-hour manufacturing process; and

WHEREAS, research at the facility has led to the establishment of the Reprocess™ Sustainable Liner Recovery Program that enables the recovery and reuse of waste polyester liner film and demonstrates the company's ongoing commitment to environmental responsibility.
