Special Meeting
June 6, 2006

A Special meeting of Cayce City Council was held today at 5:00 p.m. in Council Chambers. Those present included Mayor Avery B. Wilkerson, Jr., Councilmen James Jenkins, Kenneth Jumper, Robert Malpass, and Rick Myer, City Manager John C. Sharpe, and Municipal Clerk, Tammy Barkley. Mayor Wilkerson advised that members of the press and the public were duly notified of the meeting in accordance with the FOIA.

Other

- A. Hearing on Appeal of Denial of Business License –
Boulevard Café

City Attorney, Mr. Danny Crowe advised that Mr. Rios was in attendance and has stated that his attorney, Mr. Mathias Chaplin, was on his way. Mayor Wilkerson stated that Council would wait on the attorney but that Council must recess at 6:40 p.m.

Mayor Wilkerson called the hearing to order at 5:14 p.m. on the appeal by the Boulevard Café on the denial of their 2006 business license. The Mayor asked Council to approve procedures for the hearing set out in the City Manager's letter of May 18, 2006 to Mr. Mathias G. Chaplin, attorney for the Boulevard Café. Mr. Myers made a motion to approve the procedures of the hearing as stated. Mr. Malpass seconded the motion which was unanimously approved. Mayor Wilkerson asked if the attorneys had any questions regarding the procedures as set forth. Neither attorney had any questions.

Mayor Wilkerson asked Council to identify themselves for the court reporter. He then asked attorneys for both the City and the Boulevard Café to do the same. City Attorney, Danny Crowe, represented the City of Cayce and Attorney Mathias Chaplin represented the Boulevard Café.

Mayor Wilkerson then asked that City Attorney, Danny Crowe, proceed with presenting the City's License Official's case. Mr. Crowe called Capt. Darwin Fullwood of the Department of Public Safety to obtain testimony regarding the hearing. Mr. Chaplin cross-examined Capt. Fullwood.

At 6:30 p.m. Mayor Wilkerson advised that the proceedings of the Hearing would need to be continued at a later date due to advertised Public Hearings that were to take place at 7:00 p.m. After discussions with Council and both attorneys, the continuance of the Hearing was tentatively scheduled for July 18 at 5:30 p.m.

There being no further business, the hearing adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
