

ELIZABETH DAVIS, PH.D.,
BECAME FURMAN UNIVERSITY'S
12TH PRESIDENT ON JULY 1, 2014.

Dr. Davis previously served as Executive Vice President and Provost of Baylor University in Texas, where she oversaw the university's 11 schools and colleges as well as more than a dozen research centers and institutes. She had been a member of Baylor faculty since 1992 as a Professor of Accounting.

Her other administrative roles at Baylor included serving as Vice Provost for Financial and Academic Administration, Associate Dean for Undergraduate Business Programs, and Acting Chair of the Department of Accounting and Business Law. She served two years as Interim Provost before being named Executive Vice President and Provost in 2010.

During her time at Baylor, her teaching honors included receiving the Hankamer School of Business Teaching Excellence Award and the Mortar Board Circle of Achievement Award. Davis' scholarly work has appeared in leading journals, and she most recently co-authored the textbook *Managerial Accounting* with her husband Charles Davis. She is a recipient of the Lybrand Gold Medal awarded by Management Accounting. Before joining Baylor, she spent three years at Arthur Anderson & Co. in New Orleans.

Davis received her Bachelor of Business Administration degree from Baylor in 1984 and earned her Ph.D. from Duke University in 1992.
