\$144 Million Invested in Project Jackson in North Augusta

Project Jackson will feature a new hotel / conference center and baseball stadium

The city of North Augusta and private investors will spend more than \$170 million on the development of a baseball stadium and hotel / conference center complex along the Savannah River. Called Project Jackson, the mixed use riverfront development will be the new home of the Augusta GreenJackets baseball team and have the capacity to host larger meetings, which city leaders say is needed in Aiken County. Construction is expected to cover three years and the project will create or sustain more than 2,500 jobs. The development will also have restaurants, retail, office space, luxury apartments, condominiums, and a Family Y.

The GreenJackets is part of the South Atlantic League and affiliated with the San Francisco Giants of Major League Baseball. Its new stadium will seat 4,500 and will be a venue for other major sports events, tournaments and concerts.

The development is the latest along the growing riverfront area in North Augusta.
