The Executive Order will establish the Veterans Policy Advisory Committee (VPAC) to advise the Military Base Task Force. Recall that our office agreed to issue the order establishing this committee if Rep. James Smith withdrew his bill continuing the study committee. The language of the order has been approved by Bill Bethea and is awaiting final approval by Rep. James Smith as well.
