H.4482 is an interesting piece of legislation that names the Columbian Mammoth the official State Fossil and originates from a letter written to Governor Haley by Olivia McConnell a third grader of New Zion, SC. The bill was amended and received second reading yesterday with language proposed by Sen. Peeler. In addition to naming the official state fossil, the bill now creates a moratorium on the enactment of legislation establishing official state symbols and emblems unless there is future legislative action to remove the moratorium.
