Gov. Nikki Haley announces "Constitution Day" and "Constitution Week"

COLUMBIA, S.C. – Governor Nikki Haley today issued a statewide proclamation designating September 17 as "Constitution Day" and the beginning of "Constitution Week," lasting until September 23.

The proclamation recognizes the 226th anniversary of the signing of the United States Constitution which secures the blessings of liberty and justice for all Americans. It also establishes an effective government structure that has endured since America's founding. The governor encourages South Carolinians to renew and deepen their appreciation for the unique heritage passed on through the Constitution.
