Study shows farmers have high approval ratings

It's just as we thought: Consumers are happy with their food supply and the farmers who grow it, according to a recent national survey.

A nationwide study commissioned by the American Farm Bureau Federation (AFBF) and the Philip Morris companies reported that, overall, consumers are pleased with their food supply.

"Farmers generally have a good understanding of food issues important to consumers," the AFBF said. "They also estimate consumer satisfaction quite accurately on most points."

The research was conducted by Roper Starch Worldwide and sought to pinpoint consumers' views and expectations of the food supply, modern farming practices, as well as to learn farmers' perspectives on farming practices and meeting consumer demands.

The vast majority of consumers surveyed agreed that farmers produce foods that are nutritious (91 percent), look good (92 percent), are affordable (84 percent), are safe to eat (82 percent) and are flavorful (79 percent).

Producers have chance to comment on conservation plans

Animal feeding operations can receive nutrient-management help with the draft Technical Guidance for Developing Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plans, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture is urging the public to comment on the draft.

If you wish to comment, the deadline is March 7.

The draft is part of a conservation plan which groups conservation practices and management activities. When combined into a system, the plan ensures that both production and natural resource conservation goals are achieved for animal feeding operations. Therefore, if you have an animal feeding operation, it's important to state your opinion.

The draft Technical Guidance will give landusers instructions on how to follow the management plans. The draft is not a proposed regulation. You can read the draft for yourself at www.nhq.nrcs.usda.gov?PROGRAMS/achcwpa/ahCNMP.html.

S.C. receives USDA funds

South Carolina will receive \$1.6 million from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Environmental Quality Incentives Program. The money will be used to help landowners practice soil and water conservation.

One million dollars of the money will fund 14 priority area projects at Lake Marion, Black Mingo, the Little Saluda River, Central Kershaw, Scape Ore Watershed, Penny Shanklin-Morrow Creek, the Lynches River, Black Creek, Lamar-Oates, Rafting Creek Providence, South Fork Edisto, Shaws Creek and Muddy Creek. The rest of the money will be distributed to all S.C. counties to address the statewide natural resource concern.

Commissioner's Column

Plant and flower festivals to begin soon

For years, thousands came. In 1997, there were two, and almost 70,000 people went. In 1998 and 1999, there were three, and 100,000 people attended them.

With one more, who knows how many people will attend in 2000.

I'm talking about the Spring Plant and Flower Festivals, which are organized by the S.C. Department of Agriculture. About 15 years ago, we began holding the Southern Plant and Flower Festival at the Pee Dee State Farmers Market in Florence. Now, that one festival has blossomed into four, with the Charleston Spring Plant and Flower Festival as our newest addition.

If you've been to one of our flower festivals, you know why they have become so popular—they are truly spectacular. That's because there are literally acres of plants, flowers, outdoor furniture and other gardening products. The Southern Plant and Flower Festival, the oldest, is of course the largest, and more than 60,000 people attended last year, despite poor rainy conditions during the first day. Plants, flowers and garden decor and tools stretched out as far as you could see, thanks to the many vendors who wouldn't dare miss the festival. After all, major portions of their yearly sales come from the event. Perhaps more importantly, each vendor establishes many new customer relationships during each festival, and that means repeat business. More than 100 vendors set up shop at the Southern Plant and Flower Festival last year, and we are expecting at least that many this year.

That's good news for shoppers. The more vendors, the more selection and variety. And from what I've heard, it's the variety that keeps people coming to the festivals in droves.

"We love it — we wouldn't miss it," said Lynn Roof, who shopped at the Midlands Festival last year. "The prices are good and everyone's really knowledgeable."

Shoppers and vendors were so pleased with the Southern Plant and Flower Festival, we mimicked the event at the Columbia State Farmers Market for the Midlands Plant and Flower Festival, and then in Greenville for the Piedmont Plant and Flower Festival. Both festivals, though young, have also been huge successes. So this year, we are introducing a new site.

The Charleston Spring Plant and Flower Festival will make its debut at the Exchange Park, also known as the Coastal Carolina Fairgrounds, on U.S. 78 in Ladson. It will be held April 6-9, from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. Thursday through Saturday, and 1-6 p.m. on Sunday. For this festival, SCDA teamed up with the Charleston County Clemson Extension Office.

The Midlands Plant and Flower Festival will be held at the Columbia State Farmers Market on Bluff Rd. April 13-16, the Southern Plant and Flower Festival will be at the Pee Dee State Farmers Market on Hwy. 52 in Florence April 27-30, and the Piedmont Plant and Flower Festival will be held at the Greenville State Farmers Market at 1354 Rutherford Rd. May 4-7. Each festival will have the same daily hours as the Charleston festival.

We at SCDA put a lot of hard work into these festivals for two reasons: to help our floriculture businesses in the state and to help consumers find exactly what they want. With so many species of plants and flowers in one place, it's easy to find what you want. And there is the added bonus of having plant experts on-hand to answer your gardening questions. Also, our vendors depend heavily on their sales at each festival. The only problem is that it's becoming increasingly difficult to keep up with demand, but we've asked our vendors to plan ahead for a busy season this year. I am sure no one will be disappointed! Fortunately, there is still time for vendors to reserve spaces for each festival. If you are interested, call Dick Felder at (803) 734-2210.

If you haven't yet shopped at our festivals, this year will be a great time to start. You can stock up for all your spring planting needs in one place. My only advice for you is to wear a good pair of walking shoes and bring something large enough to carry your plants and flowers home.
