Action Items: Week of April 28th

- Data Request: Continue to move forward in securing SC data (lead: SC)
- Work Plan: Review and finalize updated draft work plan (SC and SF)

Contracting and Funding: (1) NSO/SFI and counsels to outline timing for developing recommendation for potential contracting, fund flow structure, and clearinghouse model (NSO/SFI); (2) Discuss and refine with SC (Legal and Finance Work Group); (3) identify potential sources of outcome payment for PFS (SC)

Target Population Definition: Using age and income as screening criteria, a) develop an operational strategy for outreach and enrollment (Program Design Work Group); b) review data to assess NFP's impact among these mothers (SC, Program Design); and c) determine the number of eligible moms in SC by county/zip code

Expansion Strategy: NSO to develop recommendation for expansion strategy to reach these mothers (NSO, Program Design Work Group)

Referral Concept: Based on potential screening criteria, outline "process flow" of these mothers and identify methods for

engaging these mothers in different regions of the State and at different points in the system (lead: Program Design Work Group)

Risk-Adjusted Service Delivery: Set up conversation to provide SC with more information on NSO's current testing of STAR and timing of data availability from pilot (e.g., impact and operational feasibility) (NSO)

Summary of 4/28 Full Team Call

- Teams directionally agreed that age and income could be considered as screening criteria for "high-risk".
 - Program Design Work Group to refine as operations & enrollment process are defined
- Discussed how broad or narrow the target population for the PFS should be. **No decision**, but will be further discussed in the program design call.
- SC requested scheduling a call to further discuss the STAR program and its potential incorporation into the PFS program
- SC clarified that including a proposed contracting and fund flow structure in the CMS request was ideal. NSO/SF will prioritize this work, develop an initial recommendation, and refine in partnership with the State.
