I am writing today to request your recommendation for a representative of the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services to serve as a member of the South Carolina Trauma Advisory Council.

The Trauma Care Act of 2004 provides organizational support for the state's voluntary trauma system and establishes funding for hospitals, physicians, and EMS agencies that provide the comprehensive services and resources necessary to have an effective trauma system. The Act also establishes a Trauma Advisory Council within the Division of EMS and Trauma. The Council provides suggestions and advice to the Department.

The Trauma Advisory Council typically meets on the fourth Thursday of the first month of each quarter from 10:00 a.m. until approximately 1:00 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 22, 2009.

Ms. Zenovia Vaughn currently represents the Department of Health and Human Services; however, our records indicate that her term has recently expired. We are asking that you, as Director of the SC Department of Health and Human Services, make a recommendation for a representative from your organization to serve on this Council. Appointments to the Trauma Advisory Council are for a term of three years, however, members may be reappointed if desired.

I encourage you to appoint a representative who is sincerely interested in the issues surrounding our state's trauma system and who will be dedicated to attending the meetings of the Trauma Advisory Council as often as possible.

Please notify Mr. Greg Kitchens, Trauma System Coordinator, of your organization's recommendation.


