

The Budget Commission met in the office of the Governor,  
Saturday morning, at 11:30, November 15, 1941.


Senator R. M. Jefferies and Mr. Winchester Smith were present  
and Mr. John K. Cauthen represented Governor Harley.

A delegation consisting of Ralph W. Lillard, Robert L. Avinger  
and W. S. Hendley, Jr., representing the South Carolina Junior Chamber  
of Commerce, appeared before the Commission and requested a contribution  
of \$75.00 from the Civil Contingent Fund to cover the cost of awards to  
the composers of the song "A Little Bit South of North Carolina". The  
Commission approved this contribution.

The Commission also approved a Contingent Fund Warrant in the sum  
of \$960.00 for extra clerical help for Governor Harley.

The Commission also approved a Contingent Fund Warrant for \$30.49  
to the Hotel Wade Hampton to cover inaugural expenses of Governor Harley.
