4444 Broad River Rd." - Lt Cunningham = Direct Quote

She and her superiors (BRCI and SCDC) have just now
imposed a DEATH SENTENCE on us.

People have died in insulated homes, what chance do

imposed? I wish these charges to be included.

Brings forth the charges: Harassment, Slander/Verbal Abuse and Threats of Violence (ex. Mace, "seen in a cell (?)"). As mentioned on the BRCI KIOSK. And I NOW would like to add the charges of: Attempted Murder By Neglect, Aiding and Abetting In Non-Volunteered Suicide, Allowing And Forcing To Be Put In Bodily Harm/Death, or The forcing of Petitioner to "Stand His Ground", from the threat of theft and harm from theft. To Stand His Ground

The Harassment, Slander/Verbal Abuse and Threats of Violence are a direct product of BRCI and SCDL as a whole. Petitioner has made known his many complaints for a long time (even to you) and no one has responded.

Certain officers of BRCI are under the impression that what they say will not matter in a court of law. That they can with immunity speak in a way that causes the normal person to disregard their Christian Walk (Lieber- Lee County). And the

person or persons (inmates/me) are to simply absorb the verbal abuse as a grain of salt/sand.

If it is now frowned upon to "Fat-Shame, Gender Bash, Racial Profile/Slanderize, or mock the faith/belief of how someone Worship's, how can any SCDL/BRCI Staff Violate the personal belief that a person has of themselves, simply because they/we/I happen to be a prisoner of the State?

* Sgt Barr / Sgt Tolan-Lucas are the Prime two examples I lay charge as the Verbal Abusers. My being in prison doesn't make me gay, nor have I EVER been with Another Male (not a child-teenager-young adult or older gentleman). NEVER!

My last name is Irby (Ur·bee), not Arby (as in the food place), and not Ir·by (long 'I' at the 'y'). So if I've told Sgt Barr how to pronounce it properly, how can she write me up for not responding when I'm called? How can 72hr deadlock be warrant by my not responding to a name that is NOT MY NAME!?, and I've went over it with her three times. Irby = Ur·bee (like the insect). How do I get punished?

I'd written up Sgt Barr and Lt Cunningham (she'd backed Sgt Barr's actions and words) on Kiosk to the Grievance and Security Sections,

I'd received an OTR (Order To Report) to the BRCI

Mail Room at 9am Dec 2 or 3, 2015. No announcement of Mail Room not being opened until 10-11am had been made, and nor had any calls of yard movement. A few inmates and I were waiting patiently, until a large group of inmates came from outside, AND the C.O. (now Sgt) Paige, working the other side let out a good portion of inmates from her side; OUT. I complained of the OTR's and HAD to comply (Order To Report = Direct Order), mine being legal mail (response from United States Supreme Court Washington D.C.). Sgt Barr said I be 72hr deadlock and written up for my "attempt of escape" because I walk out the door when she'd unlocked it to allow other inmates inside, Lt Cunningham backed up Sgt Barr, saying that I was creating a disturbance. I showed her the OTR, she said she didn't care. That, she was allowing Sgt Barr to run Murray Dorm as she (Sgt. Barr) saw fit. That if Sgt. Barr would not let us out, period, was her discretion! I repeated that I had legal mail to pick up. "So. You'll get it when you get it. Today, tomorrow or next week. You are to do as you're told." I asked if I was to kiss Sgt. Barr's backside, since Sgt. Barr had told me too! "Should I obey that, it was an order." I had grievanced this on Kiosk. "Do as you are told.;" "We take that as a threat.;" "Nothing more to discuss since you said lawsuit.;" the Kiosk responses.

I told Lt. Cunningham that my case is important to me and is being seen if it'll meet the 1% criteria that the U.S.S.C demands. And it did. (Nov 25, 2015.) She still didn't care, I asked for her to write down as much as she remembered of ALL of what she heard (claimed to only have heard me curse Sgt Barr, but, not Sgt. Barr's order to kiss her backside) and then sign and date it. "You will not tell me how to do my job." I made the request two more times. She made the same statement, then added to Sgt. Barr's Threat of Violence of Macing me, and "Seeing me in a cell."

Not sent to Lock Up, not the 72hr Dead Lock that Sgt. Barr had threatened. "Seen in a cell." (Older inmates say that's were they beat you while you're blinded by mace and shackled; I take this as a direct threat upon my health, my sanity, and my life. Now my life is being placed in further danger by a decision passed down from SCDC. I've already been forced to wear a shoe(?) that must be worn all year, every day. For Every Thing.

* The Cocks - Shower Shoes

• Shower Shoes - shoes to be worn in the shower

Not outside, across the yard. Not as recreational shoes. Not as protective feet coverings during cold or rainy

weather. Shower Shoes. Approved by State to cut cost, at the inmate's health expense.

- The temperature in Murray Dorm is Crazy! The cells temp. nearly matches outside, and showers so hot, you can't stand directly under it. People have died in their homes because of how cold it was. BRCI Staff says that the inside temp. meets standard. How?
- The hooded brown coats are about to be taken from ALL SCDL Inmates. They provide very little protection as it is, but they're better than the two types of tan coats I've seen. The older and newer versions. The human body loses heat more from the outside limbs. Primarily, the head and hands. The tans have one or NO pockets. SCDL has already taken the gloves we bought (no refund, and labeled contraband) so we have no protection for our hands (can't put them inside our pants - jacking!) We aren't allowed to wear our coats or knitted stocking caps inside the dorms, unless we're inside our cells. Where's it's been colder.
- Many lawsuits will come because of this. I include myself with those that will. I have no money of my own and can not afford the \$5 fee of BRCI / SCDL Medical, nor the \$5 fee per medicine.
The Cold Will Kill Us, Me.
This is a Death Sentence.

- Locks and Lockers are about to be taken. Leaving us no where to hide (if that's what you want to call it) or protect our personals from "plain view of sight." This will lead to an increase in theft of better than 75% my lowest guess (today's example). Many inmates will be harmed because of this. Those like myself believe in keeping and protecting what's ours. Other's will seek to take it from them/us, by force. "Theft, injuries, death, is what this will lead to," from the mouths of 4 blue shirt CO's and 3 white shirts (2 sergeants, 1 Lt.) The 4 blue shirts claim to be looking for another job! "Too much work, locking-unlocking doors. Having to pay for an inmate's stuff, if it happens on my shift," - Quote By these actions; My Life Is At Risk (for no cause of my own). I've brought this to the attention of BRCI Authority; "Sorry you feel that way. Only you have complained. Since you mentioned a law suit we have nothing further to say," - Quote. Why? Under Grievance on the kiosk.

I claim these charges as my own, to be brought forth and charged on BRCI and SCDC. Since only I feel this way, I can claim these charges under Targeting. In which I now so do.
