## **WHO WILL STAND UP FOR JUSTICE AND WHAT IS RIGHT?**

The actions of the SC Attorney General and the SC Senate Ethics Committee make it legal for members of the General Assembly to get away with Ethics violations ten times worse than what they alleged against me.

If you look at what this group did and how they were treated versus the Senate Ethics Committee crucifying actions towards me.

The Senate Ethics Committee ruled a month ago, they are changing the way they treat Ethics. This happened when members of the Senate Ethics Committee had major questions about their own Ethics spending. I have been told by many people that there are two sets of rules, one set that protects their own and the other doles out a standard of unfairness, unjust actions and unequal justice.

My entire life has been dedicated to fighting for equality and civil rights for everyone. Now, we have men whose job is to uphold justice misrepresenting everything that is right. Who is this state will stand for what is right?
