It was good to talk with you this morning. I'm attaching the DOR letter which states that powdered alcohol falls outside of the regulatory authority of DOR. What this means that if Palcohol is approved by the feds for a labeling license is that it will sold without state regulation. In other words, it appears that it could be sold to minors aside from the fact that it would fall outside of the our state's requirements for sale.

I'm running into some libertarian opposition over here on 2nd reading on a couple of House bills. We will be sending back at least one House bill that is ripe for amendment. Our staff attorney, Katherine Wells, will email you our language for a ban. Thanks for whatever you can do to help make a ban on powdered alcohol happen.
