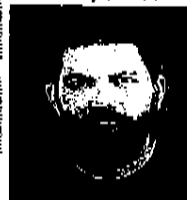

Dog helps save girl in West Ashley pond; Deputies arrest father for neglect

WEST ASHLEY, SC (WCSC) - A family dog played hero and helped save the life of a 3-year-old girl Thursday night in West Ashley. The girl's father, however, was arrested on child neglect charges.

Rescue crews were called to the Hickory Hill subdivision in West Ashley around 7 p.m. and found a girl in the water. A witness told authorities that he saw a dog nudging the girl to keep her from going under water. She was neck and chest deep in the pond located behind her house.

The girl's sister was also outside when the incident happened.

Crews from the St. Andrews Fire Department and Charleston Fire Department pulled the girl from the water and she was transported to Roper St. Francis Hospital.

The witness went into the unlocked residence and found the girl's father, 33-year-old Adam S. Gray, asleep in his bed. After several attempts, he was able to wake him.

Deputies with the Charleston County Sheriff's Office later arrested Gray and charged him with unlawful neglect by custodian. While at the Charleston County Jail, Gray was also served with a bench warrant for failure to appear in another case.

Gray told authorities that he was watching both his daughters all day and that around 5 p.m. he put them inside their cribs when they fell asleep and he closed the door to their room. He then went inside his room and fell asleep.

According to the sheriff's office, the two girls pushed down the gate that was located at the edge of the stairs inside the house and were able to go out the side rear door of the house into the backyard toward the pond.

The witness heard the dog barking and the child's voice from his yard and went over to check. The children's mother was called and she took custody of them.

Over the past 2 ½ years I have been in a "David vs. Goliath" battle with primarily the Charleston County, SC Department of Social Services. A losing battle with this state agency does not fare you well with the family court system.

I had very little resources to fight a fair fight, much less an unfair one. All accusations and founded accusations against the South Carolina Department of Social Services concerning hidden, false and manipulated information presented in cases to the family courts throughout South Carolina over the past decades applies in my case.

A couple of years ago I went through a very rough time of constant physical domestic abuse from the man I was living with, who is also the father of my twin daughters. When I finally made the move to get out of the relationship to protect myself and my daughters...came the anonymous phone call to DSS. This began a nightmare of events that concluded with the closing of the case and me losing custody of my daughters, and a man waiting outside the courtroom doors just so he could flash me a wink and whisper to me "I told you so".

Please Understand, the Department of Social Services and the Charleston County Family Court took the Children from me the mother who has always been the primary caregiver for my daughters, had the jobs and occupation, owned the homes and was involved in volunteer youth coaching and gave the children to the father who has no occupation and never held a solid job, been in and out of Alcohol treatment and drug facilities, has more than enough criminal domestic violence charges to negate him ever being considered a primary custodian to a child, and to top it off...has prior arrest and conviction of child neglect concerning the children they gave him custody???. The Department of Social Services and the Charleston County Family Court system bullied and bull-dozed this through until closure. None of this information concerning the father was ever presented to the family court. I truly believe my daughters are in grave danger in their fathers care and this to be an emergency. It is only a matter of time before they are harmed physically or mentally beyond repair.

Note: I mention the volunteer youth coaching because I love teaching children to swim and I

love coaching competitive swimming. This vindictive move by the father and it's handling by DSS and Charleston County Family Court has threatened me ever being able to offer this to the community again. This is not right.

South Carolina Department of Social Services and the Charleston County Family Court totally disregarded any of the "shall" follow and recommendations concerning domestic violence in South Carolina Code of Laws Title 63 Chapter 15 or Title 16 Chapter 25 Criminal Domestic Violence.

I have pleaded and pleaded with agencies throughout South Carolina for help. I have come to realize any agency, department, or organization within the DSS referral system might as well be DSS itself. Raising issue with the "internal affairs" department of DSS only brings repercussion from DSS.
