Tony,

Where are the legal services dollars going to be allocated from?

We currently have a line item under Title III B on our NGA for Legal Services of \$8,815 of federal, \$519 of state and with our contribution of \$1,037 of local we have a total of \$10,371. To have a viable Legal Services program, the Regional Aging Advisory Committee has assigned priority to legal services.

In order to prevent a reduction in services from previous years, CMCOG would need an additional \$40,000 in Title III B funds (including federal and state).

After updating the October 2013 payment (where I moved \$1,019 from Title IIIB to IIIB legal, we're showing a negative revised current balance of \$-891.00 on the payment request form.
