**Roads – Senator Young’s Comments about Concurrence:**

“The House of Representatives returns to session this week and it is expected to debate the roads bill after the Senate passed it last month with SCDOT governance reform and without a gas tax increase. Meanwhile, during the budget debate last week on the House floor, the House passed amendments providing an additional \$415 Million in state funding to go toward road infrastructure in the state. House members should strongly consider concurring with the Senate amendments to ensure that the SCDOT governance reform in the Senate version of the bill becomes law.”
