- \$1,000.00 TO \$2,499.99 .....CLASS B - \$100.00
- \$ 200.00 TO \$999.99.....CLASS C - \$ 50.00
- \$ 199.99 OR LESS
- WHERE ONLY BOXED, PACKAGED VEGETABLE
- AND FLOWER SEEDS ARE HANDLED .....CLASS D - \$ 25.00
