A dear friend of the Independence Hall Foundation, **Janet Cantor**, sent the press release below, announcing **Marco Rubio** as a recipient of the Foundation's *2015 Jefferson Defense of Liberty Award* for his work to free the **Cuban people**, to human rights activist, professor, and renowned author **Carlos Eire**. It fascinates me that the Pope will be visiting prisoners of Philadelphia jails, who get there by committing crimes like rape and murder and theft, and yet can find no time to visit with prisoners of Cuban Gulags most of whom only got there by wishing to be free.

Excellent! and so rare!
I'm amazed. Pretty soon giving awards to conservatives will be illegal,

especially to Lateeeeeeen-oh conservatives!
Too bad the pope's trip won't coincide with this event. He could have been invited.

Our award to Marco Rubio is a small gesture, but it carries with it a huge prayer on this, the **239th Anniversary of the Declaration of Independence** -- that the nation of Cuba, 90 miles off the coast of Florida, may one day experience the same precious freedom and liberty granted to us by our **Founders** with the blessing of our **Creator**.

**Foundation Names Marco Rubio as Recipient of Its 2015 Defender of Liberty Award for His Work to Free the Cuban People; Condemns Obama Administration for Re-establishing Relations with a Terrorist Dictatorship
Calls Rubio's Leadership on Cuba a Profile in Courage**

Philadelphia, PA (July 2, 2015) -- In advance of its July 3rd event, the Independence Hall Foundation Board has announced, today, that Senator Marco

Rubio has been named the recipient of its *2015 Jefferson Defender of Liberty Award* for his strong support of a free Cuban nation.

At the same time, the Foundation condemned the Obama Administration for re-establishing diplomatic ties with the brutal Castro dictatorship that has exported communist revolution and terrorism.

"Yesterday, in the White Rose Garden, President Obama said that he is moving forward with the establishment of an embassy in Havana, Cuba. That action is an affront to all of those, in the Western Hemisphere, who hold liberty dear to their hearts," said Foundation spokeswoman, Teri Adams.

"Why is the Obama Administration propping up the Communist Cuban government just when it appeared to be on the verge of economic collapse due to diminished financial assistance from its key ally, Venezuela?"

"Establishing relations with Cuba, now, will not lead to the liberation of the Cuban people, it will enable the Castro brothers to maintain a firm grip over the island nation.

"To his credit, Senator Rubio, who has staunchly opposed the corrupt Castro Regime throughout his political career, has promised to lead the effort, in the US Senate, to block the President's appointment of a US Ambassador to Cuba--a strategy we wholeheartedly support," said Ms. Adams.

"In its more than 50 year of dictatorship, the Castro regime has committed unspeakable atrocities against its own citizens, including widespread murder, torture, and political incarceration. It has exported communist revolution to Nicaragua and other nations while forming alliances with drug cartels in Columbia and elsewhere.

"Until this year, Cuba was listed as a terrorist nation by the US State Department. And to this very day, it is harboring US fugitives.

"Our nation owes a debt of gratitude to Senator Rubio for not giving into the enormous pressure to accept the normalization of relations with Cuba. His is a profile in courage," said Ms. Adams.

Last year, on July 4, the Foundation presented the 2014 Jefferson Defender of Liberty Award to Natalia Shyrba, a representative of the American-Ukrainian organization Razom. Ms. Shyrba accepted the award on behalf of the Ukrainian People.

The annual Defender of Liberty Award, established in 2013, is given to an individual, or group of individuals, who courageously defend the notion of liberty as advanced by Thomas Jefferson in the *Declaration of Independence*.
