Your veto didn't print; let me know if there is a new version, otherwise I'll just print what you asked initially.

Arts Commission – Most of that line is federal, but about \$85,000 is “other funds” which is revenue from endowment grants, donations, and their training conference fees. All of their federal revenue from the past few years have been from ARRA/SFSF and an NEA partnership grant.

State Museum – I think that this is a Les question, but there are lines in the budget (Adjutant General and Education come to mind) where FTEs are placeholders for lines that have no funding. I think that a veto of the funding does not necessarily delete the FTE, and we can word the veto message accordingly... “I believe that the museum has sufficient flexibility to cover these functions with remaining resources”.
