Dear Mr. Harris:

Thank you for submitting your application for the renewal of your Hobby Diver License. Unfortunately, we will not be able to renew your South Carolina Hobby Diver license #5365. Enclosed you will find your returned check.

When you originally applied for a Hobby Diver License you acknowledged reading the summary of the South Carolina Underwater Antiquities Act and agreed to abide by all requirements of the law. Your license will not be renewed on the grounds that in the past licensing period you violated the terms of the licensing agreement in the following ways:

Per S.C. Code Ann. 54-7-670(G)(1) provides in part, "All reports under this license must be filed with the state prior to submitting application for renewal of a hobby license. The institute will not consider applications for renewal until all outstanding reports have been received."

The outstanding reports in question are for Quarters 1 (January-March) and 2 (April-June) of this year. Concerning the required Quarterly Report information, all reports must include the following details as outlined in the hobby licensing agreement: each dive report shall include a list of all artifacts or fossils recovered during each quarter and the location from which those items were recovered per S.C. Code Ann. Section 54-7-670 (H)(1). To the extent you have submitted Quarterly Reports, they do not contain all the required information.

We are in receipt of your most recent reports but they are incomplete. A separate report should be filed per dive location, for each dive, outlining what specifically was collected. If you have any questions or comments about this matter please contact our office.
