Attached is a two page document I used in my budget process this year to set forth my observations of the Executive Branch after 3.5 years. All I had to do was tweak the documents I gave the Senate Judiciary Committee on May 24th. I had a one page overview statement & nine pages of higher level data of mission, strategies, and results/impact. I got more if you need. I can also re-shape what I have sent you to meet your needs.

The IG is likely the most transparent agency in state government, where all my work is on my webpage, with the exception of misconduct and pending fraud cases.
