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SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, June 6, 1985

TEACHER LOAN PROGRAM

In December 1984 the Commission adopted regulations governing operation of the Teacher Loan Program, as authorized by the Education Improvement Act of 1984. In April 1985 the Commission filed notice, as required under the State Registry Act, that regulations be promulgated. The notice included an invitation to the public to submit written comments or to request a public hearing. No such comments or requests were received. The Commission voted on June 6 to submit the regulations for publication in the State Register, constituting promulgation of the regulations.

The Commission approved the budget of \$77,970 for the administration of the Teacher Loan Program in 1985-86 as recommended by the S.C. Student Loan Corporation.

The Commission approved revisions in the Appropriation Formula for Continuing Operations for 1986-87.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

1985-86 Annual Permanent Improvement Plans of the public colleges and universities were approved as summarized below: The Citadel (10 projects), \$1,275,966; Clemson University (29 projects), \$3,325,000; College of Charleston (18 projects), \$807,000; Francis Marion College (3 projects), \$248,000; Lander College (3 projects), \$205,000; Medical University of South Carolina (2 projects), \$5,375,000; South Carolina State College (7 projects), \$659,000; USC-Columbia (19 projects), \$5,688,000; USC-Spartanburg (3 projects), \$200,000; USC-Sumter (1 project), \$50,000; Winthrop College (8 projects), \$1,069,000; and State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education (2 projects), \$98,475.

DESEGREGATION PLAN ALLOCATIONS FOR 1985-86

The Commission approved the budget for the State Higher Education Desegregation Plan for 1985-86. The total amount available (\$3,857,347) was allocated in the following categories: Enhancement, Graduate Incentive Fellowships, Public School District Projects, Other Desegregation Plan Activities at State Institutions of Higher Education, and Commission Administration.

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
