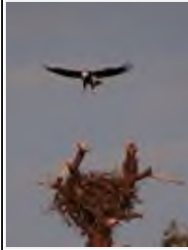

As the temperatures drop & winter nears, take a look at the sky to identify some migratory bird species! The Bald Eagle is a crowd favorite arriving at Hunting Island to begin their nesting season. These large birds of prey are typically identified by their characteristic white heads and tails, but this iconic plumage isn't developed until the birds are about 5 years old.
